How do I know which program to choose?

Your program of choice will depend on factors like preferred curriculum, preferred amount of support, schedule, testing method, assessment type, etc. But don't worry, you can take our program recommendation questionnaire to discover the best fit for your child's needs and your family's lifestyle.

A specialized developmental service is available for exceptional or challenged learners, auxiliary to the Touch - Curated program.

How early can I start homeschooling?

For students aged 2 and 3, HG's nursery program uses the Kidstarter Curious Curriculum, while Pre-K students aged 4 may take any of the Touch - Curated, or Tech - BJU. DepEd accreditation officially begins in Kinder, and the child must be 5 years old by June 1. For those who will be turning 5 between August 2 to October 31, students must take the Kinder Readiness Test first. For Grade 1, students need to be at least 6 years old.

Can I work and homeschool at the same time?

It is certainly possible to work and homeschool your children. We recommend that you use a structured program (Online Academy, VCIS Online, or Tech -BJU) that will allow you to be your child's learning facilitator rather than the teacher if you are not able to dedicate the recommended 2 to 3 hours daily for teaching time. As a facilitator, you connect the child with the learning tool and curriculum, and supervise and guide them.

The Tech - BJU program is very helpful as it provides comprehensive video lessons by subject specialist teachers. The Online Academy program provide additional assistance to facilitators through Class Advisors who monitor progress, provide lesson schedules, and conduct weekly homeroom classes. VCIS Online includes daily live online academic classes including grading and teacher supervision, additional synchronous class time for lessons and guided work, guidance on flexible weekly schedules, daily homeroom meetings, and weekly study halls.

Are you DepEd-accredited?

We offer two forms of accreditation, US and Philippine accreditation. The Philippine accreditation is provided by our partner school, The Master's Academy, which we have been partnered with since we pioneered homeschooling in the Philippines more than 20 years ago. The US accreditation is provided by our partner school, Wellspring Christian Family Schools based in Maryland U.S.A., a Tier 1 NCAA-accredited school, and is particularly beneficial for those who are planning to enroll their child in a college abroad or are expats.

I am a Filipino living outside the Philippines with my children. Can I still enroll my children through HG?

Yes, you may enroll under the US accreditation through our US partner school. You may also enroll under the Philippine accreditation through our Philippine partner school's distance learning program. HG accepts enrollment under all learning tracks and for all grade levels regardless of their legal residence or location. All students completing our DepEd-accredited programs will receive their duly accredited report cards, certificates, diplomas, and TOR, at the end of their school year. These students will be assigned their own unique Learner's Reference Number (LRN).

Which accreditation should I choose: Philippine or US?

In choosing the accreditation, you must factor in future plans. Both types of accreditation are recognized in the Philippines and abroad. We have had graduates accepted into top Philippine universities such as UP, Ateneo, and De La Salle, as well as international universities such as Brown, NYU, Stanford, and University of Georgia. Under the US accreditation, students will not be required to study Filipino language or Araling Panlipunan, but rather, US History and a foreign language. By default, all our programs include Philippine accreditation in the fees; the US option is available at an additional fee.

Grades 11 & 12 US accreditation are available under Touch -Curated and Tech - AOP with multiple elective options.

Whichever accreditation you choose, it will not be impossible for you to transition to conventional schools, should you wish to in the future. Conventional schools will recognize the academic records issued by our partner schools. Some conventional schools may have additional requirements for incoming students with foreign documents.

What are our options if we are a Filipino family residing in the Middle East, in light of DepEd DO No. 001, s. 2022?

According to the abovementioned DepEd order, students residing outside the Philippines may enroll with Philippine schools that offer Online Distance Learning (ODL) programs. Alternatively, if you opt for US accreditation, your child will be a student of a US school and will not be covered by the DO. Below is the summary of available options for families enrolling in HG this school year:

TECH, ONLINE ACADEMY, and ONLINE ACADEMY PLUS Programs up to Grade 10

- a. Enroll into the above online distance learning (ODL) programs offered by our Philippine partner schools
- b.Enroll into the US version of the above programs (US accreditation through WCFS)

TOUCH Programs up to Grade 10

- a. Enroll into the Touch homeschool program with US curriculum and accreditation through WCFS
- b. Enroll into one of the Touch homeschool programs with PH curriculum through HG's US accreditation

Grades 11 and 12

- learning (ODL) programs offered by our Philippine partner school
- Enroll into the Tech AOP or Touch homeschool programs with US curriculum and accreditation through WCFS

If we are under HG's US accreditation, can I decide to enroll my children in a **PH-based conventional school in the future?**

Yes. If parents prefer to shift their students to PH-based conventional schools in the future, academic credits granted by HG's US school accreditation will be recognized in line with the usual practices of enrollment from foreign schools.

Will my children still need to take the **Philippine Educational Placement Test** (PEPT) to validate their school years with HG?

The Philippine Educational Placement Test (PEPT) is for learners without accreditation. Since all HG programs come with school accreditation, HG students are not required to take the PEPT.

How do I choose the curriculum, books, and materials appropriate for my child?

If you choose the Online Academy, Tech - BJU, or Tech -AOP* programs, these follow curriculum packages which include the books and materials you will need for the school year. The package will be purchased together with enrollment and books, shall be provided within 14 days** of enrollment. For all Touch programs, you will be provided a book list upon enrollment, which contains our recommended books as well as a list of optional/alternative books you may purchase, including online/digital platforms such as BJU DLO and AOP Ignitia. You may also schedule a curriculum consultation with a learning advisor who can guide you in making your choice.

What is the difference between Touch, Tech, and Online Academies?

HG program categories are differentiated according to level of support and type of parental involvement required. All three Touch programs require parental instruction and include comprehensive support and guidance from advisors.

Tech programs only require parental supervision and include platform-drive essential advisor support. Each Tech program utilizes a different type of curriculum: fully online (Tech - AOP) and blended (Tech - BJU).

The Online Academies programs, on the other hand, include teacher supervision, grading, and optional academic classes, and only requires minimal parental supervision.

What is the difference between Tech - AOP and Tech - BJU?

Tech - BJU is a blended curriculum provided by BJU Press, and features a blend of online comprehensive video lessons (on-demand) by expert teachers and materials, as well as printed books and worktext books for the student that come with the curriculum bundle. Tech - BJU is for Pre-K to Grade 10 students.

Tech - AOP, open to Grades 3 to 12, is a fully online curriculum provided by Alpha Omega Publications. This means all of the lessons and materials will be available online. Tech - AOP is ideal for visual and independent learners who may not need comprehensive video lessons but would benefit from the interactive text-based curriculum. This online curriculum is ideal for high schoolers as it includes an array of electives and test prep courses (SAT, GED, etc.)

Both programs provide essential academic support from an advisor, which includes grading guidance, online platform navigation, and exams.

What's the difference between Tech - BJU and Online Academy?

The main difference is that Online Academy has Class Advisors. They are in charge of the weekly homeroom classes and help parents monitor their child's weekly progress. Both programs use BJU DLO as their curriculum, which features recorded videos of lessons delivered to your child on-demand by expert teachers.

What's the difference between Online Academy and VCIS Online?

Online Academy includes weekly homeroom classes with a Class Advisor, who also does the grading of academic subjects, as well as provides lesson schedules and weekly progress reports. VCIS Online offers a full virtual school experience, including daily live online academic classes anchored on a high-quality Biblically-integrated curriculum and learning plan; live class time for lecture, guided work, and flipped learning; daily homeroom meetings, and study halls for additional tutoring.

What strands are available for Senior High School (DepEd)?

For school year 2023-2024, HG offers two (2) tracks under the Philippine accreditation:

- Academic Track
 - GAS General Academic Strand
 - ABM Accountancy, Business, and Management
 - STEM Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math
 - HUMSS Humanities and Social Science

Does enrollment follow the conventional school calendar?

Enrollment for families happens every March, June, September, and December (US accreditation only). Thus, interested families have the advantage of starting homeschooling earlier or later than June. The school year should ideally be completed in 10 months; however, you have the flexibility to take the program up to 12 months, free of charge. You may also extend up to a maximum of 15 months, except for those under the December cycle (pro-rata fees apply).

Are installment plans available?

Our programs offer one-time, two-monthly, fourmonthly, and quarterly payment scheme options. Curriculum and books are paid for in full upon enrollment.

Can I hire a tutor?

Yes, you may hire a tutor to assist with homeschooling. The tutor may undergo the included training programs together with the parent.

HG also offers Online Group Tutorials in Math, Science, English, Filipino, and Social Studies for Grades 1 to 10 students under Touch, Tech - BJU, Tech - AOP, and Online Academy (PH and US accreditation) through the help of professional teachers. Good for one academic year (or 10 months), the tutorial will happen in a group setting wherein your child will join other students of the same grade level. There is a set mini-lesson for 15 minutes, but the majority of the time (35 minutes) is given for students to ask questions via chat while the teacher will discuss these questions or finish with a check up game or activity if there are no questions.

Is Bible a curriculum requirement?

HG welcomes and serves homeschooling families regardless of faith or religious background. Seeing through the years the genuine transformation in the lives of many families and students who applied biblical principles in everyday living, HG promotes Bible-based values education (EPP/GMRC) for homeschoolers as a curricular requirement by its accrediting schools. The Bible is a required integral textbook and is central in all the curricular offerings of HG and all its accrediting schools (TMA and WCFS).



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
